



Oxford Downs Changing room and showering facilities policy



As an ECB affiliated cricket club, Oxford Downs have a Changing room and showering facilities policy.

These guidelines apply to the arrangements made for adults, and children, using the changing and showering facilities.

Children and adults **must not use** the same changing facilities at the same time.

Best practice principles are adopted by Oxford Downs Cricket Club.

These are as follows:

- All adults **must not** change, or shower, at the same time using the same facility as children.
- Boys can use the first team changing room to change or shower, when it is free from **all** adults. The team captain will ensure that the first team changing room is empty for boys to use, if they wish to change or shower.
- Female adults or girls can have access to the umpire changing room and showering facilities, once the umpires have finished using it. The team captain will ensure that the umpire changing room is free for use by any female adult or girl wishing to use it.
- Due to the risks of inappropriate photography or filming, mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms.
- If children are uncomfortable changing or showering at the club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so. It is suggested that instead that they may change and shower at home if they'd prefer to do so.
